- Flight playoff to proceed flighted round robin in Districts for USTA

 which teams advance to round robin play.
- <u>Match format change</u> for all leagues in the Denver Metro area, the default format for league play will be to play a 10 point tie break in lieu of the third set unless all players agree to play out the third set to its entirety.
- New league added to schedule and new division for Trio Due to popular demand a women's division has now been added to the Trio league. Also by popular demand, we have added the CTA Silver Senior league which will be solely for those players who are in the 70+ age group.
- <u>Tennis Link Face-lift</u> Tennis Link will be changing its user interface as 2011 progresses.

Upcoming changes for 2012:

- Additional time slot to be added for USTA Adult and CTA Twilight an additional time slot will be added to the USTA Adult and CTA Twilight to help with court demands and those facilities that are at max-capacity. The new time will be 4:00 p.m. in addition to the ever popular 6:00 p.m. time slot.
