

**PROCEDURES IN CHAMPIONSHIPS COMPETITION TO DETERMINE THE
FOURTH TEAM FOR SEMIFINAL PLAY IN A THREE FLIGHT ROUND
ROBIN**

Addendum – Method determined by the championship committee for use during Colorado District Championships when any of the flights have a different number of teams.

- II. The remaining semifinal play-off spot shall be determined from the second place teams by the first of the following procedures that does so:
- a. If each flight has the same number of teams, the procedures shall be the same as those in I. above.
 - b. If any of the flights have a different number of teams, the procedures shall be determined as follows:
 1. Games. The team with the highest percentage of games won in the round robin.
 2. A method to be determined by the championships committee: procedure to be announced prior to commencement of championships competition.

Procedure to be used* :

1. Advancing team will be the 2nd place team that has the highest percentage of Individual wins during the flighted round robin. This will be calculated by dividing the number of Individual wins as listed in championship standings by the total number of Individual wins and losses.
 - a. If a team had 6 individual wins and 3 individual losses, the resulting percentage would be 6/9 or 66.67%.
2. If there is a tie with the percentage of individual wins, the tie will be broken by the team with the lowest percentage of sets lost. This will be calculated by dividing the number of Sets lost by the total number of sets played during the flighted round robin.
 - a. A 3rd set score of 1-0 will count as a set.
3. If there is a tie with the percentage of sets lost, the tie will be broken by the team with the lowest percentage of games lost. This will be calculated by dividing the number of Games lost by the total number of games played during the flighted round robin.
 - a. A 3rd set score of 1-0 will count as a game.
4. Draw a team name out of a hat.

* Individual defaults count in the calculation. Percentages will be calculated to the hundredth.
